2 · Journey Controls

- plan the route, rest stops and expected arrival time;
- set check-in points and a nominated contact;
- manage fatigue — limit driving hours, share driving, rest breaks;
- carry communications, water and a breakdown / emergency kit;
- check the vehicle is roadworthy before departure.

3 · Responsibilities

- **Management** — provide resources, set expectations and review effectiveness.
- **Supervisors** — apply this procedure on site and verify controls.
- **Workers & contractors** — follow this procedure and report issues.
