- establish defined access routes, speed limits and exclusion zones;
- use spotters, signage and barriers for reversing and blind spots;
- fit and use reversing alarms and beacons;
- manage interaction with the public and other contractors.

3 · Responsibilities

- **Management** — provide resources, set expectations and review effectiveness.
- **Supervisors** — apply this procedure on site and verify controls.
- **Workers & contractors** — follow this procedure and report issues.
